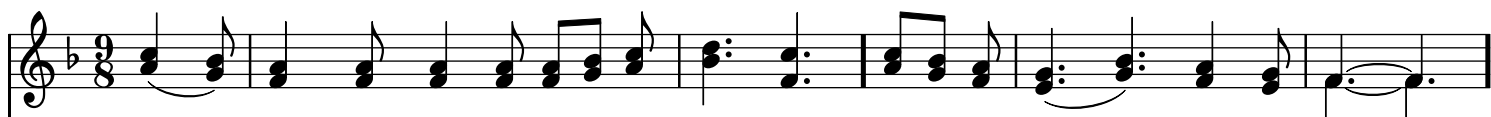


## By Faith I See the Saviour Dying

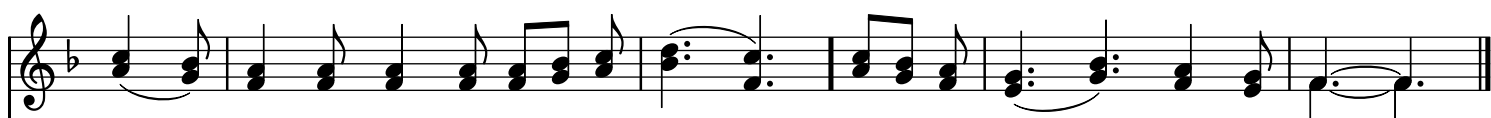
1. By faith I see the Sav-iour dy - ing      On the tree,      on the tree;
