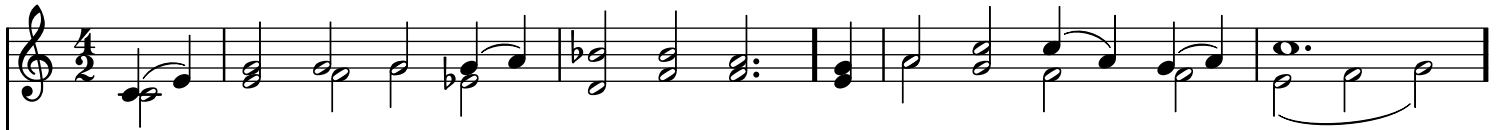


Behold the Lamb! 'Tis He Who Bore
