Sources of information of the COVID-19 cases reported in the Pacific Island Countries and Territories

Since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Pacific Community (SPC) Public Health Division is closely monitoring the global and regional situation through its epidemic intelligence system and produces weekly epidemiological reports on COVID-19 cases reported in the Pacific.

Data and information are collected and received from different sources, especially official reports released by Pacific Governments, Ministries or Departments of Health that are available in the public domain (see details below). We also closely monitor other sources of information, like media reports, but we always verify the information with the Pacific Governments, Ministries or Departments of Health to ensure that the data and information are accurate.
