COUNTRY STATEMENT - KINGDOM OF TONGA

A. Significant events 1987-91.

- 1. Development of Artisanal Fisheries funded by FAO, UNCDF, and Japan. Sum of \$800,000 was allocated towards building of 40 boats (24, 28 and 30ft). Funds were loaned to fishermen through the Tonga Development Bank. (Problems repayments/repossession).
- 2. Fish Marketing Centre
 - i. Main market in Nuku'alofa funded by EEC constructed in 1987 and opened the following year.
 - ii. Fish marketing facilities in 8 out-stations funded by Japanese aid. (Problems - electrical failures/availability of spare parts).
- 3. Establishment of public company Sea Star Fishing Company Limited (SSFCL) in 1990; targeted towards exploitation of tuna industry and other fisheries activities e.g. fish processing, marketing etc.
- 4. New Ministry of Fisheries created on 4 February, 1991. (Problems personnel and financial).

B. Description of present status of the fishing industry.

The Ministry of Fisheries is still in a state of flux.

C. Promotion of marine resource development.

- 1. In addition to above, Japanese aid is offering further assistance in aquaculture for the next five years.
- 2. Further training of staff.
