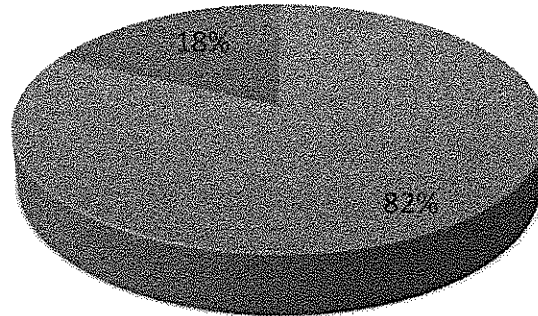

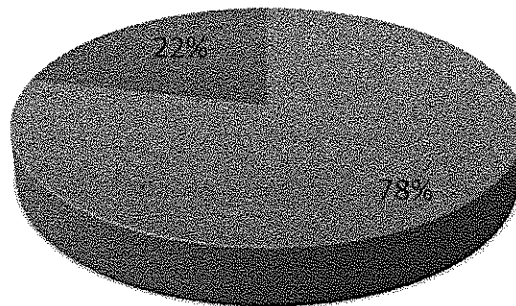
Primary Enrollment Distributions

■ Public Primary ■ Private Primary



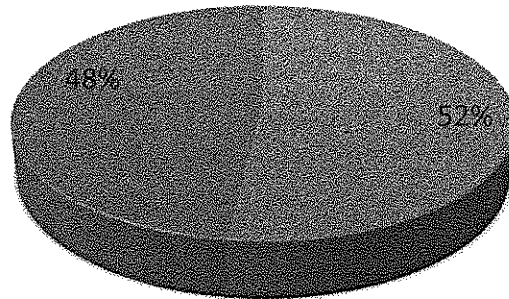
Secondary Enrollment Distributions

■ Public Secondary ■ Private Secondary



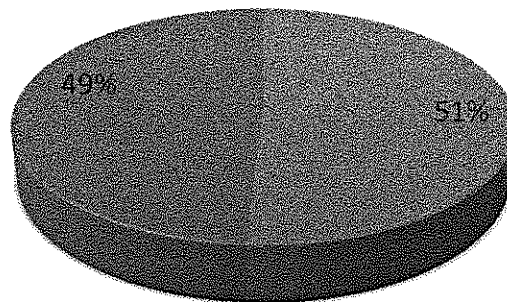
Public Primary Enrollment 2010-11

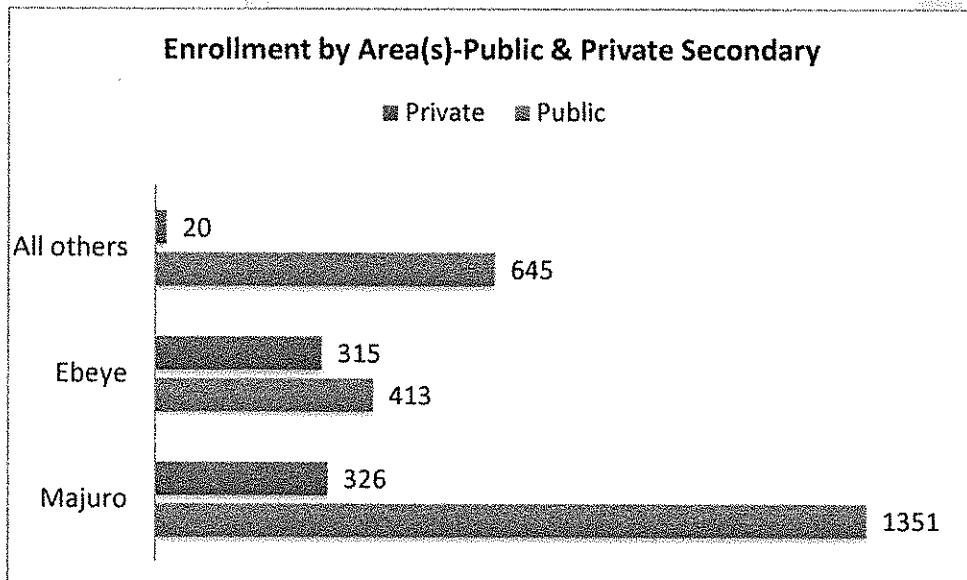
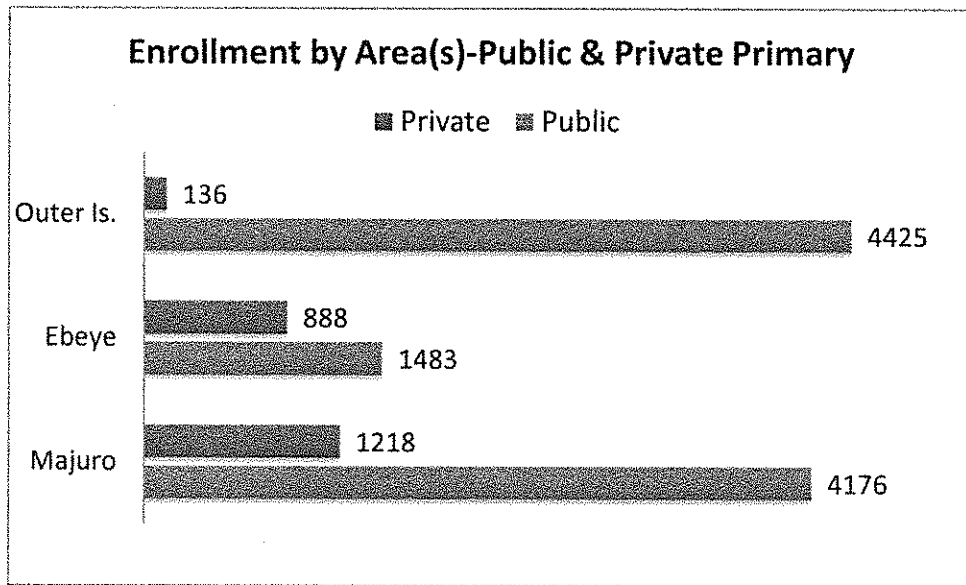

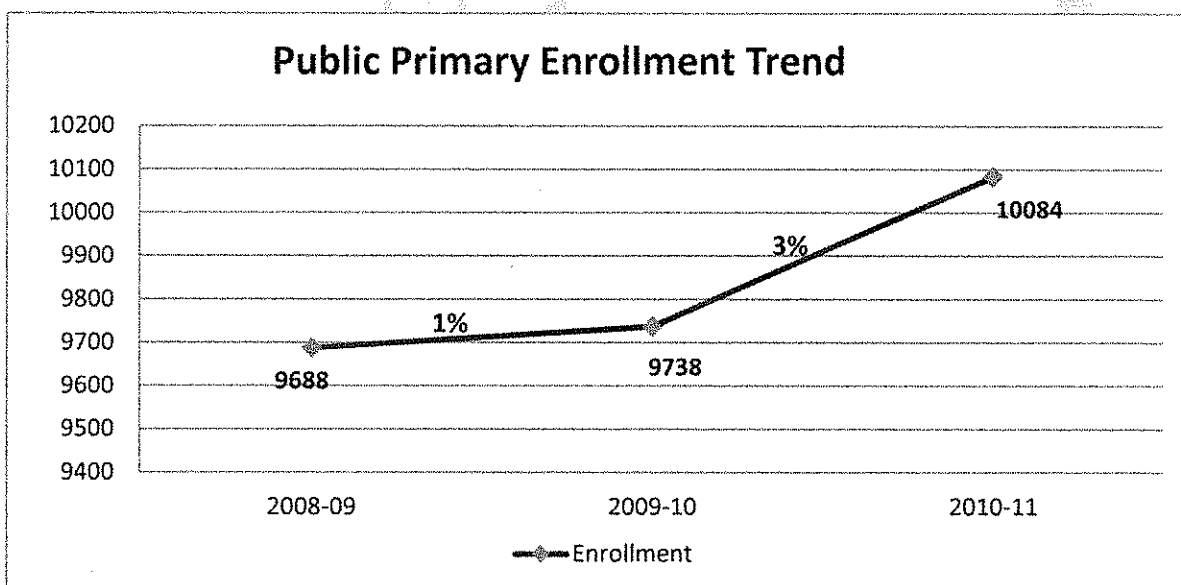
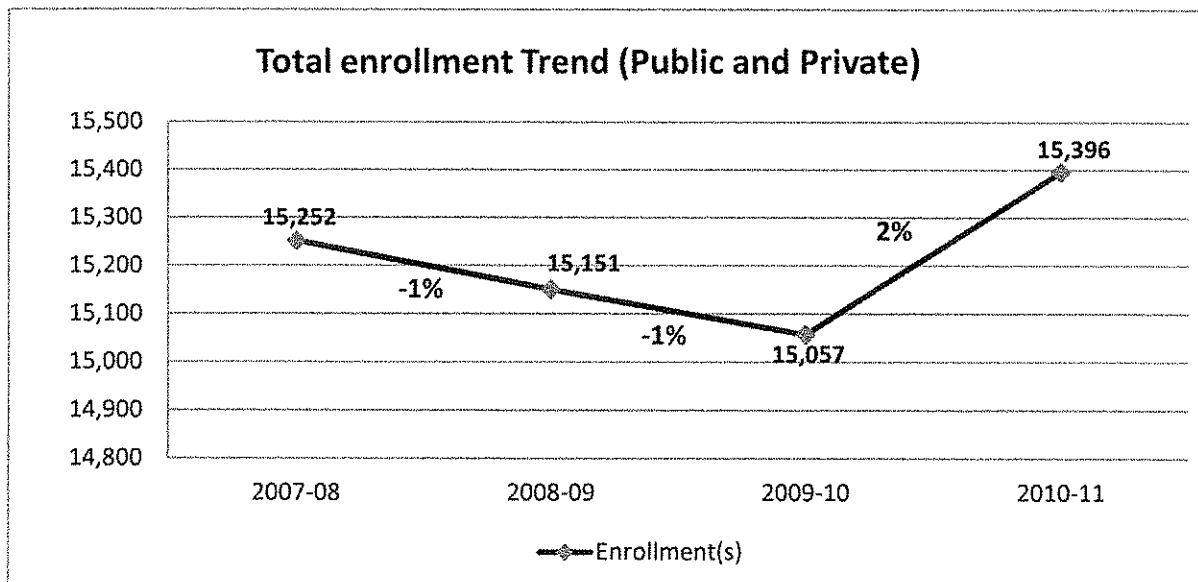


Private Primary Enrollment 2010-11

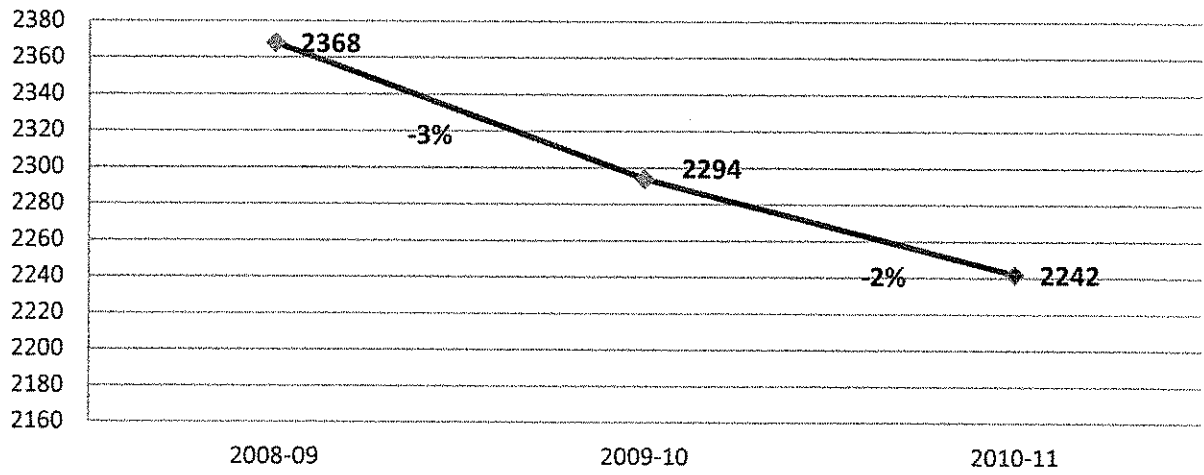

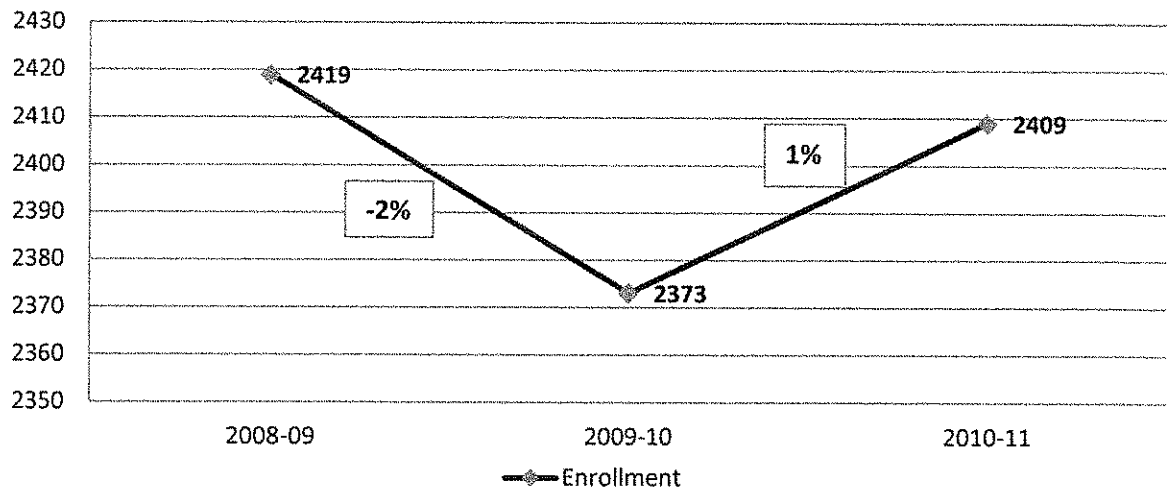




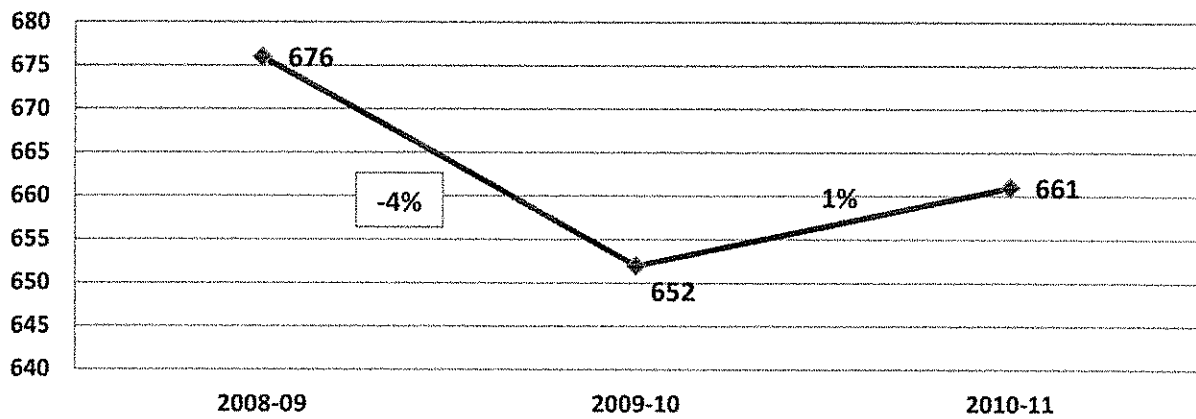
Private Primary Enrollment Trend
