## Introduction:

Funded by the EU, the Building Safety and Resilience in the Pacific Phase II (BSRP II) is a follow-up to the BSRP project that was implemented in the Pacific Island Region between 2013 and 2020. With a budget of EUR14 million, BSRP II is implemented by SPC in collaboration with agencies from 15 Pacific Island countries as part of the 11th European Development Fund (EDF) Intra-African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) Natural Disaster Risk Reduction Programme (NDRR) supported by the Organisation of African, Caribbean and Pacific States (OACPS) and the European Union Delegation (Suva).

The project is governed by a Project Steering Group (PSG) made up of NDMO Directors from participating countries and SPC, with the EU and OACPS as observers. The Project Steering Group was formed and held its first meeting in March 2023. The role of the PSG is to monitor progress and provide oversight and guidance to the Project Management Unit. It also serves to strengthen communication and coordination with, and between, participating countries leading to a greater level of engagement and country ownership of the project.

- Review and endorsement of the 2023 Annual Report
- Review and endorsement of 2024 Workplan and Budget. Discuss constraints concerning funding for output-based SPC travel and technical positions
- Share information on planned national activities under selected KRAs
- Discuss opportunities for capacity development and clarify process and budget for travel support for countries
- Broaden understanding on risk financing and select pilot countries for risk financing pilot interventions
