- Merging the two technical working group
- Using survey and admin data together

II. Key Issues/Challenges

- Both the work of the two working group was not moving forward
- Administrative data is outside the control of NSOs will need to move beyond the traditional data – tax, trade, civil registration, etc
- Countries with NSDS have made improvements
