



OUTLINE

• ESRI ArcGIS online geoportal – A cloud-based online enterprise (100 licenses) government wide platform lead by EMCI which holds our data sets, maps and other products. Allows for different ESRI applications such as ArcGIS Pro, ArcGIS online, Survey123, Field Maps, Instant Apps, Story Maps, plus more. Introduced to the Cook Islands in 2019.






 CookGeo – Both online and offline server lead by Infrastructure Cook Islands which contains spatial data. Achieves sovereignty over Cook Islands data sets.




IMPORTANCE & RELEVANCE

ARCGIS ONLINE PORTAL

ALLOWS FOR REMOTE ACCESS. ENHANCES SHARING AND CONFIDENTIALITY WITHIN GOVERNMENT ORGANISATIONS AND SOE'S. ALLOWS FOR COMPATIBILITY WITH QGIS AND OTHER SOURCES BY BEING ABLE TO DOWNLOAD SHAPEFILES ETC. ENHANCES THE CREATIVITY AND HIGH LEVEL DISPLAYS USING VARIOUS TOOLS AND APPLICATIONS. DASHBOARDS FOR EXAMPLE, HOST ALL OUR DRM DATA SETS AND EXPOSURE MODELS TO EFFECTIVELY ASSIST DECISION MAKING DURING EMERGENCIES. EASE OF USE ACCESS FROM DATA COLLECTION TO MAPPING AND THEN GRAPHICAL PRODUCTS


EXAMPLE OF ARCGIS DRM DASHBOARD




EMCI DRM MAP



IMPORTANCE & RELEVANCE

COOKGEO PORTAL

ALLOWS FOR IN COUNTRY STORAGE FOR ACCESS DURING DISASTERS. DATA SOVEREIGNTY IS NOW A KEY PILLAR FOR COOK ISLANDS GOVERNMENT AND COOKGEO WILL HELP TO ACHIEVE THIS. INFRASTRUCTURE COOK ISLANDS BEING THE LEAD AGENCY FOR SPATIAL INFORMATION, COOKGEO NOW SUPPORTS THEIR EFFORTS AND ALLOWS EMCI AND OTHER AGENCIES TO HAVE BACKUP DATA SETS.





CURRENT SITUATION

ARCGIS ONLINE

Working very well and has opened up the data sharing aspect within the Cook Islands Government and enhanced inter agency relationship to build the Cook Islands GIS user group.

COOKGEO

Still being developed, website currently accessible. Working with SPC to assist with Technical difficulties.

SYSTEM NEEDS/REQUIREMENTS

Open source and different formats

Interoperability with other systems

Further development and enhancement of centralized data systems to streamline access and management

Finalize Standardization of Data: Ensure data sets are standardized to facilitate interoperability and ease of use (Draft CK GIS Standards Developed)

Strengthen Security Measures: Implement robust security measures to safeguard sensitive data

Link Portals for improved efficiency and accessibility

Accessibility for both government and non-government entities

Improvements in hardware and software infrastructure

User-friendly interface for easy access and analysis



MAIN CHALLENGES

ARCGIS ONLINE

COOKGEO

- Financial Constraints
- Limited expertise and Lack of regional/free capacity building for Esri products.
- Most agencies are using ArcGIS, easier to use ArcGIS online portal.
- Data uploaded to CookGeo is a platform where you uploaded and available to access. Some agencies just want somewhere to store information but have sovereignty
- Hosting the server in country has highlighted the need to improve our hardware and internet infrastructure to be effective.



STRATEGIES TO ADDRESS CHALLENGES

ARCGIS

- Financial constraints: Paid through various projects, however looking at options to distribute costs with all government agencies or government ICT to cover subscription costs. Possible donor sponsorship.
- Capacity Building: More countries in the region are now using ArcGIS, we suggest that countries join our efforts to propose that SPC and other agencies include Esri/ArcGIS in GIS training packages.

COOKGEO

Currently Working with SPC to assist in developing the server and website to eliminate technical issues. A login for specific private data to be integrated and separated from publicly accessible data.

SUPPORT NEEDED

ARCGIS

- ArcGIS Geoportal: infrastructure is already set up. We would like to encourage Esri GIS trainings on data collection, creating maps, dashboards etc. for other government agencies.
- Regional collaborations and standardization
- Sustainable funding source or strategy to support subscription costs

COOKGEO

- Technical training and expertise to maintain and develop the server and website in country
- Infrastructure Hardware Servers and High end PCs for other Ministries/Agencies to improve and share data



CONCLUSION

ARCGIS

Working well and has fostered great collaboration opportunities within the Cook Islands Government and allows collaboration with other ESRI users externally while also withstanding our information sharing guidelines. Spatial Information Policy is now in place and LiDAR has now been processed and ready for enhanced GIS products using ESRI tools. EMCI Now recognized by ESRI for Special Achievement Award in July, 2024 at International ESRI conference in San Diego, US

COOKGEO

Considering we have existing ArcGIS portal in place with immediate effect to import to maps, it makes it difficult to encourage agencies to use unless they are using open sourced software. Further development is set to take place to minimize the issues.
