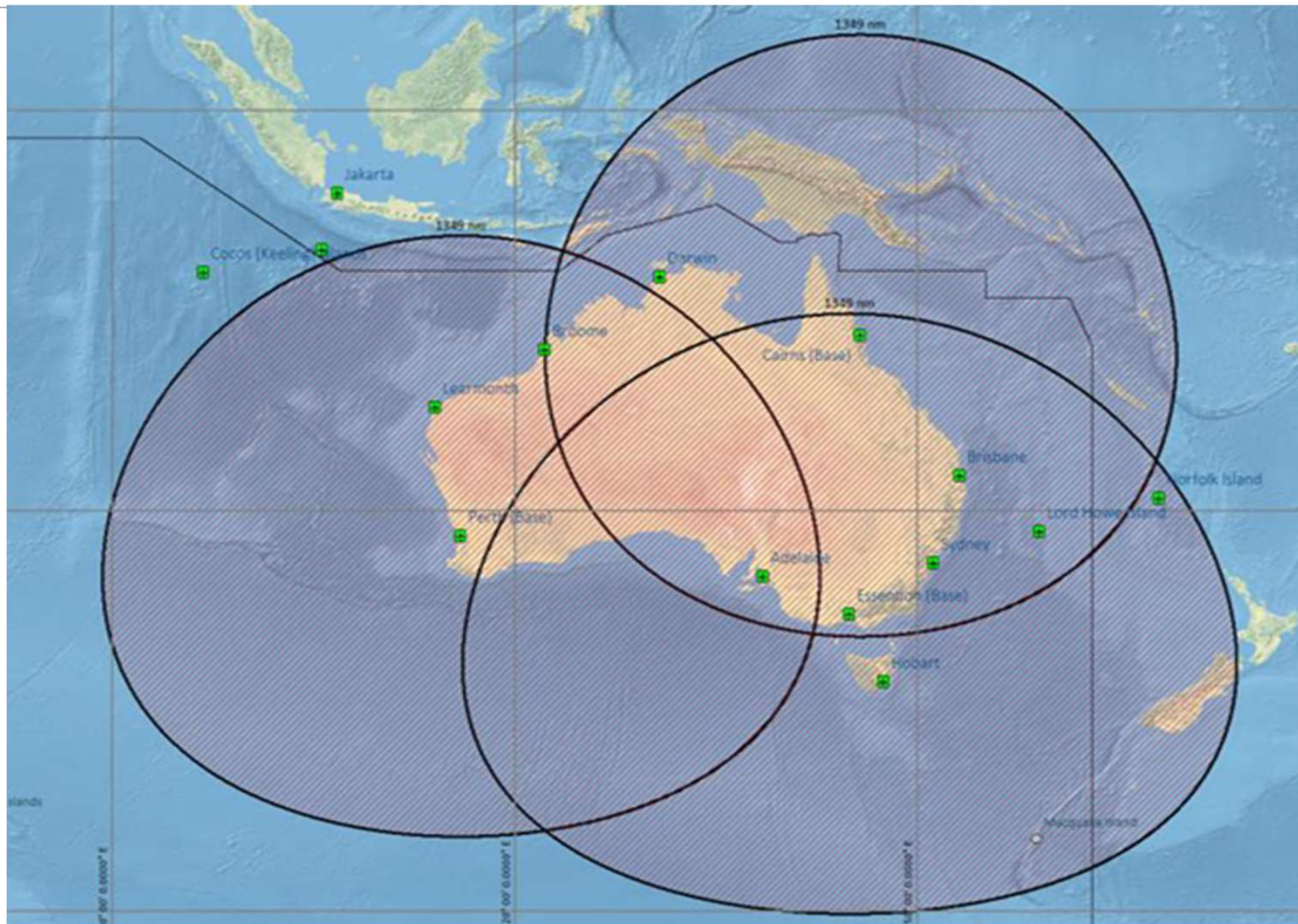

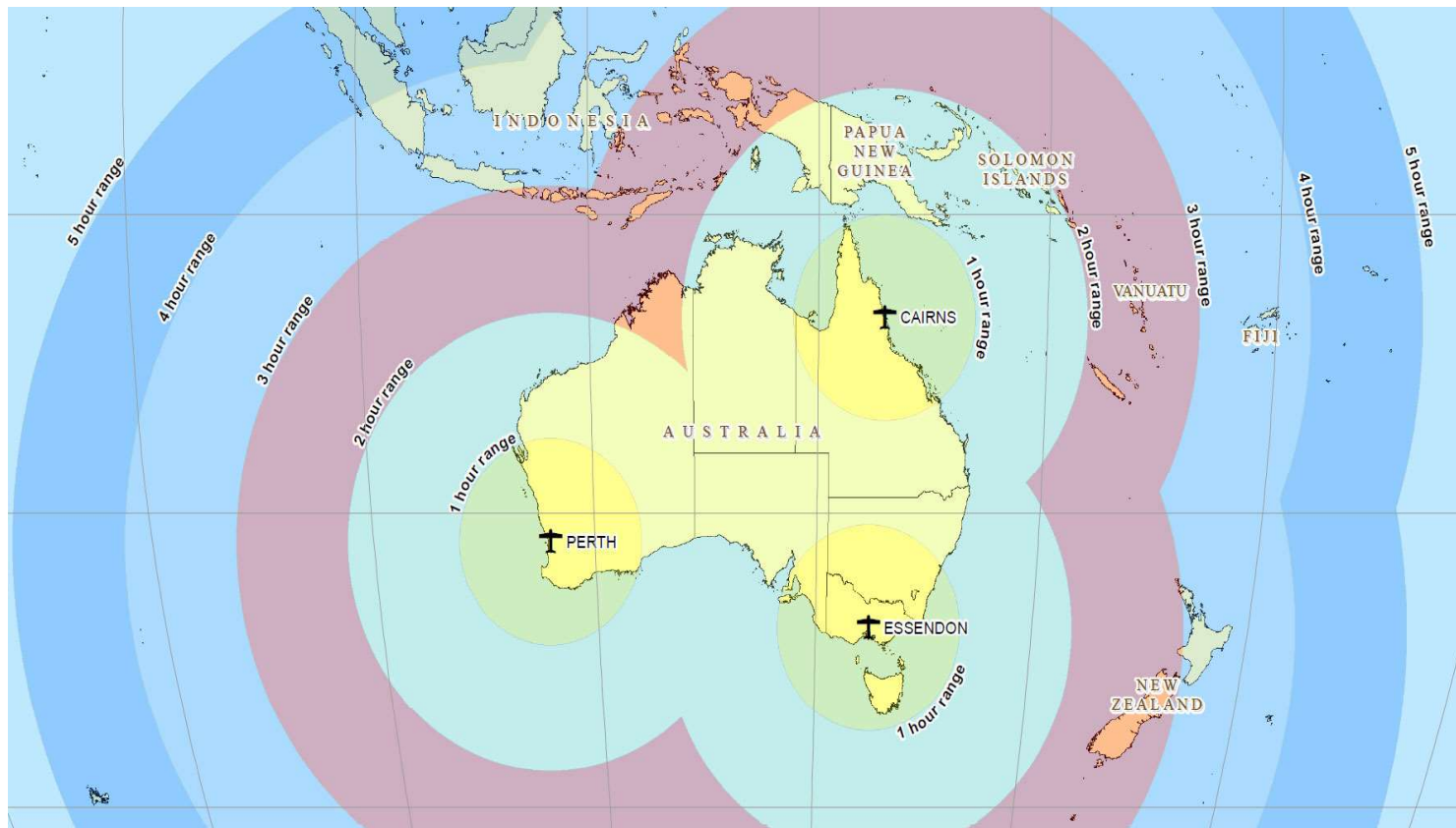

Aircraft Performance



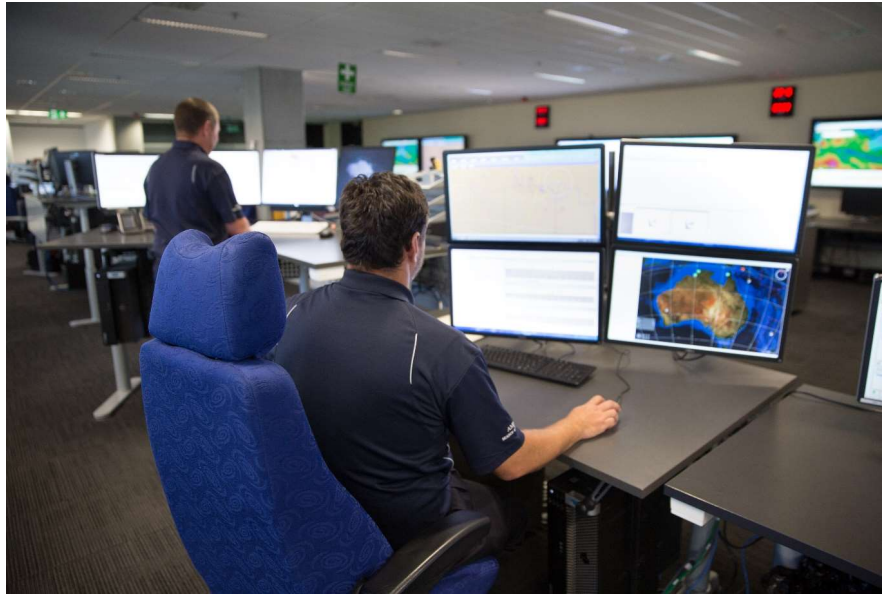
Typical Tasks

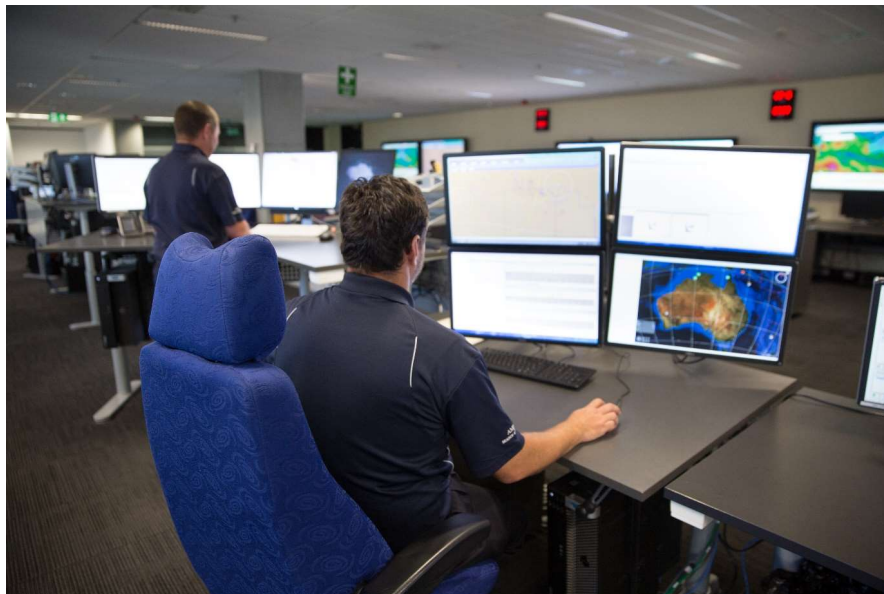


What do we need from an RCC?



- Mutual trust between the SMC, SARO's and the search crew
- Clear, timely and unambiguous communication
- SMEAC (or similar) briefing style
- A good understanding of the capabilities and limitations of the search platform(s)
- Opportunity to debrief
 - What was the task
 - Was it achieved
 - If not, why not
 - If yes, what worked well

What's useful / what's not?



- SAR is complex, try to keep it simple
- Timely passage of information and updates to situation as exists
- Detail of any other assets to assist
- Clear lines of communication between tasking authority and other assets
- Avoid over reaching / micro-managing the on scene crew(s)

What do we need more / less of?



- Rehearse, Rehearse & Rehearse
 - SAREX, desktop scenario/planning exercise
- Opportunities for SMC's to meet with search crews
- Exchange ideas, feedback loops (think contract review meeting here)
- Embrace emerging technologies
