Knowledge and Support Technical Assistance (KSTA) project 6666

Project Name: Strengthening Digital Information of the National Statistical Data Systems

Participating Countries: Nauru, Niue, Samoa, and Tuvalu

Objective: The CAPI/CATI/CAWI component of KSTA will focus on the implementation of surveys, including questionnaire design; programming on CAPI, CATI, or CAWI platforms; data validation; data transfer; and maintenance of relevant equipment or devices. Furthermore, training will be provided on the use of software to collect data using tablets, telephones, and/or the web.

Selection of CAPI/CATI/CAWI Platform: Among the open-source platforms, CSPro and Survey Solutions are the recommended platform of choice for large and complex data collection initiatives of the NSOs. To date, it should be noted that there is no single open-source platform which seem to support all three technologies (CAPI/CATI/CAWI), except CSPro for which there are upcoming feature updates to support web interviews.

- Received government concurrence and have started formal discussion with Central Statistics Division (CSD) on activities and needed equipment
- Survey implementation in collaboration with SPC
- Ongoing discussion of budget line items






