
Some popular food fish of Tuvalu (I)

Habitat: Common in surge zones of exposed seaward reefs. 0–15 m.
Max. recorded size: 38 cm.
Food: Herbivorous but also feeds on crustaceans.



Acanthurus lineatus
Pone matagi (Ntau) • Lined surgeonfish

Habitat: Surge zone of clear seaward reefs. 0–6 m.
Max. recorded size: 26 cm.
Food: Filamentous and calcareous algae.



Acanthurus guttatus
Maono (Nmaga, Nmea, NTO, Nui, VTP) Api (Ffuti, Ntau, Niae)
Whitespotted surgeonfish

Habitat: Lagoon and seaward reefs with hard substrate. 0–90 m.
Max. recorded size: 27 cm.
Food: Filamentous algae.

Koinava (Nui) • Convict surgeonfish


Habitat: Almost every available reef habitat. 3–50 m.


